SUMMARY

Following the election of Mayor Burnett as LGAQ President the position of District 6 representative on the LGAQ Policy Executive is now vacant. This report is seeking council endorsement for Mayor Williams to nominate to fill this vacancy.

OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION

THAT Council endorse Mayor Williams to nominate and fill the vacancy on the Local Government Association of Queensland's Policy Executive for District Six.

COMMENTARY

Following the election of Mayor Burnett as Local Government Association of Queensland (LGAQ) President, the position of District 6 representative on the LGAQ Policy Executive is now vacant.

The LGAQ will shortly begin a process to fill this vacancy which includes calling for nominations and if required undertaking a ballot of other district members to elect a nominee.

District 6 consists of Rockhampton Regional Council, Livingstone Shire Council, Banana Shire Council, Central Highlands Regional Council and Gladstone Regional Council.

Mayor Williams has indicated his willingness to nominate for this position for which his experience can provide benefit to all member Councils in this district.
