SUMMARY

The Black Dog Ball are requesting an alteration to the standard 10.30pm event programming curfew that is in place for the Rockhampton Showgrounds in support of their event offering for the 2023 Black Dog Ball on the 7 October 2023.

OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION

THAT Council approve the alteration of the Rockhampton Showgrounds event program curfew of 10.30pm to the stated time on following evening -

 Saturday 7th October 2023 12.00 midnight – Black Dog Ball Robert Schwarten Indoor Pavilion

COMMENTARY

The Black Dog Charity Ball, which raises funds for mental health, occurs at the beginning of mental health week. In 2023 Black dog ball has hired the Rockhampton Showgrounds Robert Schwarten Pavilion to hold its annual event. The event will have a PA system and stage which is fullly contained within the indoor element of the Robert Schwarten Pavilion.

The event will operate under a community liquor permit with service ending at 11.30pm, providing 30 minutes for guests to exit site by midnight.

BACKGROUND

Rockhampton Regional Council have a standard 10.30pm curfew for event programming in the Rockhampton Showgrounds. This has been in place since the Council assumed operation of the site. The curfew is maintained with regular users such as the Rockhampton Saloon Car Club. In this instance race meet event activities at 10.30pm with only quite operational activity and patron movement happening beyond 10.30pm.

PREVIOUS DECISIONS

Since 2015 significant events have been granted extensions beyond 10.30pm as follows -

Beef 2015 - Thursday 7th May 11pm, Friday 8th May 11pm, Saturday 9th May 11.30pm

Beef 2018 - Sunday 6th May 11pm, Friday 11th May 11pm, Saturday 11th May 11.30pm

One Hot Night (Busby Marou) - Fri 29 December 2019 11.30pm

Beef 2021 – Sunday 2nd May 11pm, Friday 7th May 11pm, Saturday 8th May Midnight

There have been numerous relaxations for similar events including Beef prior to 2015.

As the event operator Black Dog Ball is liable for adherence to noise regulation standards.

Conversely there may be reputational risks with broader community and stakeholders if restrictions affect the perceived success of the event.

Re: Request for exemption from Rockhampton Showgrounds noise curfew of 10.30pm

The Black Dog Ball is a charity ball held each year at the start of Mental Health Week. This event has become Central Queensland's Premier Event of the year.

To date we have raised \$320,000 for local mental health charities.

We have booked the Robert Schwarten Pavilion to host the 10th Annual Black Dog Ball on 7th October 2023.

Upon booking the venue we were advised there would be no problem with 12am finish time or noise restrictions.

Sponsors and their guests will arrive at 5pm for pre dinner drinks, with general admission arriving from 5:45pm. 730 guests are attending the Black Dog Ball to help us raise money for our 3 Beneficiaries this year - Headspace, Ourspace and Selectability. These non for profit organisations will be using the funds raised from this event to fund youth and adult mental health support programs.

Alcohol service will end at 11:30pm with the event closing at 12am

We are requesting an exemption from the Showgrounds noise curfew of 10.30pm for the evening.
