
YOUR KERBSIDE BIN SERVICE

IS YOUR BIN READY FOR COLLECTION? √ 30cm apart 1m from parked cars/ Away from trees and powerlines Lid closed **√** Under 85kg Collections can take place any time between 6am and 6pm on your bin day, and times may vary.

LANEWAYS & CUL-DE-SACS

In laneways and dead-end streets bins must all be placed on the same side of the road.

In cul-de-sacs bins should be placed on the straight edge before entering a cul-de-sac.



WE CAN'T COLLECT YOUR BIN IF IT:

- X Is overfull
- ★ Can't be accessed safely
- Is contaminated with hazardous waste or the wrong items
- X Is heavier than 85kg Council bin
- Is not presented at the time of service rating assessment

If your bin doesn't get collected we'll leave a sticker on your bin telling you why.

Providing the issue is addressed, we'll collect as normal in the following service.

We can arrange an additional service, however there is a fee.

If your bin doesn't get collected and you don't have a note, get in touch and, if there was no mistake on your part, we'll arrange a free missed collected service.

FEES & CHARGES

Fees for kerbside collection are included in your rates, however additional services - such as an extra bin or a return to service - will incur costs.

ASSISTED SERVICE

Assisted services are provided free of charge to eligible residents with a medical condition or disability. If you need an assisted service please get in touch to find out more.

YOUR RECYCLING BIN

Your yellow-lid recycling bin is only for household food and beverage containers, as well as paper and cardboard.

On plastic containers look out for recycling symbols. We accept numbers

THE FINE PRINT

Council does not return to service unpresented bins or incorrectly presented bins (after notice) unless the customer pays for additional services.

Where possible, bins will be left in an upright position, however fallen bins will only be righted if they fall into the roadway or driveway.

If your recycling bin is not being used correctly it won't be collected and we'll issue a warning notice. If three warning notices are issued (in a 12 month period) it will be removed.

Permanent storage of bins on the footpath is not allowed and penalties may apply.
